





#### **Potential Addition of CWG Members**

## **CWG Membership Criteria**



- 1. No more than one seat per organization across all CWGs
- 2. Nominee must live or work within  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile from the alignment/represent a group or organization focused specifically on issues within the  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile
- 3. Nominee must not be an elected official or working directly for an elected official representing San Jose, Santa Clara or Santa Clara County
- 4. Nominee must not have conflict of interests in relation to the project in the following categories:
  - a. Property
  - b. VTA current or potential vendors/consultants/contractors

## **Design Refinement Effort**



Identify design refinements for the BART station designs at Downtown and Diridon Stations that are within the extents of the currently approved project and FTA timeline for full funding grant agreement (FFGA).

This includes exploration of accommodations for future project elements.

Design refinement effort was conducted in parallel to and incorporates the CP2 Contractor's Innovations



## Single Bore: Side-by-Side Tracks w/ Center Platform






## Station Visioning for Downtown San José



- A placemaking approach to station entrances, modeling what has been done by others
- Places for gathering in the public plaza
- Enhancements of the urban landscape through architectural beauty and artwork
- Clearly indicated wayfinding for the transit patrons
- Creating the most visible and defining aspects of the system
- Avoids additional structural cost





## **Downtown SJ Station Primary Entrance Refinement**


## **Downtown SJ Station Primary Entrance Refinement**



#### **Refined Concept**


#### **Station Design Refinements**

- Larger diameter circular shaft
- Reduces number of escalator switchbacks
- Simplifies path to and from platform
- Emphasis on unique passenger experience
- Facilitates placemaking via potential for rooftop garden above station




#### **Accommodations for future South Entrance**

facilitate future connection







facilities relocated to enable high-density TOD




## **Further Refined Diridon Station Concept**



#### **Station Design Refinements**

- Consolidates back-of-house (BOH) facilities
- TOD fronting Post Street no longer subject to stringent BART design standards
- Greatly reduced cost to construct development on this site



### **Diridon Station Area Planned Developments**





Over 4,000,000 sq. ft. of office and mixed-use new development are planned immediately adjacent to the Diridon BART Station.






## **Diridon BART Station Refinements**



#### Allow for future connection to DISC

- West vent and emergency egress facility design to enable phased expansion into passenger entrance
- Future connection would require:
  - Extension of mezzanine beyond west end of platform
  - Puncture of tunnel lining once exact location is determined
  - Ongoing coordination to ensure BART operations could continue during construction


#### Contractor Innovation – Initiated Design Change


#### Reduce construction-related impacts to surrounding

- Construct platform within tunnel, instead of via cut-and-cover
- Limit excavation to station entrance shaft
- Reduce overall haul volume
- Reduce construction duration and disruption

#### Circular station entrance shaft

- Offers consistent passenger experience for all underground stations on BSVII Extension
- Accommodates feedback from 2021's Station Look & Feel effort


