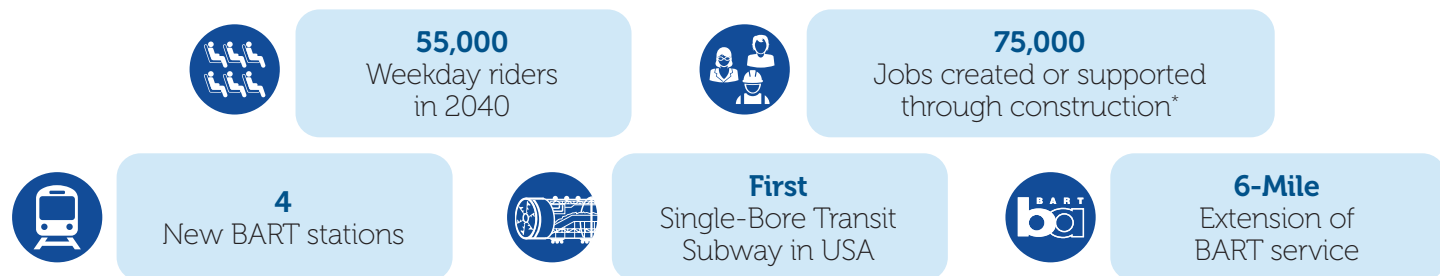

At a Glance



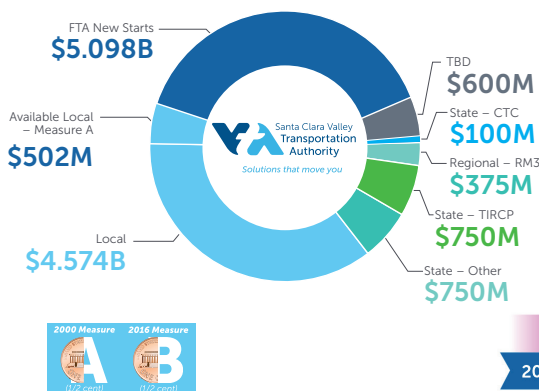
VTA's BART Silicon Valley Phase II Extension (BSVII) is a six-mile, four-station extension of BART from Berryessa/ North San José Station (opened 2020) through downtown San José to the City of Santa Clara. BSVII is planned to include an approximately five-mile subway, three stations with underground platforms (28th Street/Little Portugal, Downtown San José, and Diridon), one ground-level station (Santa Clara), a train maintenance and storage facility, and additional facilities.
